Start fair. Won cantering; second and third driving. Joe Madden, after forward pursuit from the start, drew out in the last half and held sway to the end, winning off finally. Wise Mason, prominent from the start, challenged when beginning the last furlong and held on persistently in the middle running, but quit finally. Donald Macdonald, prominent for half of the journey, was a game, persistent and fast-going third. Warfield set the early pace, but dropped out in the last half and pulled up lame. Fayette, reserved in the rear, was in difficulties early and, being hopelessly outpaced, ran a very bad race.
