It was a grand finish and Missionary was the best horse, but O'Connor had worn him out in trying to stick to Mesmerist in the early part. The latter seems to be only a sprinter, and Maher pulled him up when the pacemaking mission was ended. Ildrim was skillfully rated throughout, got up in the final furlong, and won through Turner's masterly finish. Spencer waited too long with Petruccio, who closed with a grand burst of speed and was in front a stride beyond the wire.
