Went to post at 3:55. At post 5 minutes. Start very straggling. Won easily; second the same. Masterman gained several lengths advantage at the start, which Bullman made the most of, taking a good lead, which he held throughout. Masterman exhibiting a high order of speed and stamina. Renald ran like a pronounced stayer under waiting tactics. He made a splendid stretch run under a vigorous and skillful ride, and with more seasoning bids fair to beat the best. King Hanover received a good start, was well placed throughout, but failed to make good in the stretch and was tiring badly at the end. Igniter trailed and made a strong move when called on a quarter out, after which he tired. Whiskey King was run into and his chances practically destroyed at the start, but was a good horse for a mile and a furlong. Compute broke whirling and ran into Whiskey King and must have broke down right there, as his gait was peculiar and jerky. He made up ground fast, showing brilliant speed for a mile, after which he quit completely and was eased up.
