Start good. Won driving; second same. Tanya, displaying wonderful form, was shot right along from the start and, forcing a terrific early pace, the race quickly resolved itself into a procession; shook off her nearest attendant, Wild Mint, at the end of six furlongs and came into a long lead, finishing flagging but gamely and just lasted the journey. Blandy, seemingly outpaced early, closed up very fast, but was boring out and losing sufficient ground in the stretch to cost him the race. Hot Shot ran a remarkably game race and was forced to go on the inside, where he tired right at the end. Merry Lark, trailing far in the rear for the first mile, closed a tremendous gap in the last quarter and is a genuine stayer. Wild Mint was speedy, but tired badly. The others were hopelessly outpaced from the start.
