Start good and slow. Won driving; second and third same. Prince Eugene, showing remarkable improvement and well ridden, was saved behind the leaders to the stretch, then moved up with a rush, but tired and just lasted long enough to win. Rock View was best, but was messed about when entering the stretch and, when Prince Eugene made his rush, was caught between the leaders and pinched off, then closed up fast in the last eighth and was gaining on the winner with every stride. Flying Fairy set a fast pace to the last eighth and finished gamely, but tired. Barnegat tired badly after appearing dangerous in the stretch.
