Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third driving. Friar Rock set a good pace under restraint and, racing into a long lead after entering the main track, held Spur safe through the homestretch. Spur dropped back after taking a small lead on the turn out of the Belmont course, then made a game effort at the quarter post, but tired finally. Churchill finished gamely, but never could get to the leader. Chicle ran well for a mile and was eased up in the homestretch.
