Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third driving. Johren was saved under stout restraint in the early running, then moved up with a rush in the last half and, passing War Cloud in the last eighth, drew away at the end. War Cloud was much used in racing with Cum Sah in the early running and tired perceptibly when challenged by the winner. Cum Sah set a fast pace, but tired badly after going a mile. Lanius always was outrun.
