Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third driving. American Flag, closest up from the start, passed Prince of Bourbon while rounding the far turn and, taking the lead, drew away in the stretch and won in a canter. Dangerous gained steadily on the backstretch and finished resolutely, but was not equal to the task of cutting down the winner's lead. Swope ran a good race all the way and finished well. By Hissel lacked early speed. Marconi always was far back. Prince of Bourbon showed the most early speed, but quit badly. Backbone raced poorly.
