Start good and slow. Won driving; second and third same. Blue Larkspur, away well and taken under restraint, was sent through on the inside on the far turn after being taken back for a breathing spell, responded to urging near the stretch turn and responded to pressure gamely at the end. African moved up fast when called upon, made a wide turn entering the stretch and was being ridden out at the finish. Jack High, close up throughout, moved into the lead between calls entering the stretch, but tired at the end. Beacon Hill set a good pace in the going under steady restraint, but tired badly at the end. Sunvir finished gamely. Live Oak gained ground near the end.
