Start good out of machine. Won ridden out; second and third driving. Faireno moved into command at once, was rated along steadily and, given a breathing spell on the backstretch, drew away and held the others safe to the end. Osculator improved his position and wore down Flag Pole. The latter propped at the post, then improved his position on the far turn, but tired in the stretch and pulled up lame. Gusto, outrun early, finished with a rush. Polo Bar had no mishap. Sansarica finished well. Mad Pursuit tired badly at the end. Sunmelus had no mishap. Jimmy Sutro was outrun. Laughing Queen and Villon were eased up when beaten.
