Start good and slow. Won driving; second and third easily. Granville, away well and under steady restraint in the early running, moved up with determination rounding the far turn, came to the outside of the leaders entering the stretch and, under severe pressure, wore down Mr. Bones in the final strides. The latter set a steady pace under steady restraint while saving ground, shook off Jean Bart in the stretch and held on with good courage under urging to the finish. Hollywood, kept in a forward position from the start under steady restraint, improved his position when called upon and closed gamely through the stretch. Corundum worked his way up steadily on the inside, saved ground entering the stretch and finished well. Brevity was rated back off the pace under steady restraint, was bothered slightly rounding the first turn, moved up when called upon, but flattened out in the stretch run. Memory Book showed improvement, but raced wide all the way. Teufel, a trailer in the early running, made up some ground slowly. He was fractious at the post. Jean Bart followed the early pace closely, but faltered badly at the stretch turn when called upon. Red Rain was outrun in the first part, was placed under pressure rounding the far turn, but could not gain on the leaders. Isolater tried to force the early pace, but quit badly and was not persevered with in the stretch run.
