Start good from stall gate. Won driving; second and third same. Bounding Home was steadied along in the early running, moved up with determination on the outside and responded to pressure in the late stages to outfinish Pensive in the final eighth. The latter was under steady restraint in the early stages, moved up with determination on the outside, disposed of Who Goes There and assumed command to hold on with determination to the end. Bull Dandy was outrun to the far turn, made up ground, but could not menace the leaders. Who Goes There raced Boy Knight into defeat and flattened out in the final quarter. Platter was steadied along the first part, improved his position when roused and then rnung badly. He pulled up slightly lame. Free Lance and Boy Knight had no mishaps.
