Start good from stall gate. Won driving; second and third same. Pavot was kept forwardly from the start under mild restraint, was restrained to the stretch turn, where he moved up with a rush, assumed command and drew away under pressure. Wildlife raced forwardly all the way, was blocked at the far turn trying to go through, came again and finished well. Jeep dropped back after the start and raced choppily in the early stages, but made up some ground in the stretch run. Adonis was taken under restraint and kept forwardly, but failed to gain when roused in the stretch run. Sea Swallow forced the early pace and then tired. Burning Dream stumbled at the start and almost went to his knees. The Doge had early speed. Brookfield tired badly and was not persevered with.
