Start good from stall gate. Won ridden out, second third driving. PHALANX was steadied along in the early running, moved up fast on the outside, responded to pressure in the late stages, but was under urging to the end and was drifting out at the finish. TIDE RIPS was steadied along close to the pace from the start, saved ground and held on well to the end. TAILSPIN was under restraint in the early morning, moved up when urged and finished well. YOUNG PETER, outrun early, moved up fast on the outside rounding the stretch turn, came around the leaders and in the final furlong was steered to the inside. FAULTLESS was under steady restraint in the running, dropped back when settled on the rear stretch, moved up when placed to pressure, then faltered sharply in the late stages. BRABANCON had early speed, but flattened out when urged. KHYBER PASS had no mishap. LADY'S ACE was shuffled back going to the far turn while on the inside and was eliminated.
