Eighty-seventh running THE BELMONT \$100,000 added, of which \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third and \$5,000 to fourth. 3-year-olds. Colts (geldings not eligible) and fillies. Scale weights Colts, 126 lbs., fillies, 121 lbs. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup, to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession. Starters to be named through the entry box the day before the race at the usual time of closing.

Start good. Won easily, second and third driving. NASHUA, away fastest, raced in closest pursuit of LITTLE DELL during the run down the backstretch, forged to the front on the far turn when ready and, after attaining a commanding lead nearing the furlong marker, increased his advantage through the stretch, winning as his rider pleased. BLAZING COUNT, forwardly placed during the early running while on the outside, moved into the runner-up position on the final turn, was unable to seriously endanger the winner when set down for the drive, but held on willingly to easily prevail over PORTERSVILLE. The latter, forced to take up slightly when in close quarters on the first turn, recovered readily to remain within striking distance of the leaders to the stretch, then failed to respond when called upon for his best effort. JABNEH was always outrun. FLYING FURY never was formidable. LITTLE DELL, much used setting the early pace, had little left. MR. AL L. saved ground to no avail. RETAMERO never menaced.
