1 1-2 MILES. (Gallant Man, June 15, 1957—2 26 $\frac{3}{4}$ —3—126.) Ninetieth running BELMONT. \$100,000 added. 3-year-olds. Scale weights. By subscription of \$50 each, to accompany the nomination. Supplementary nominations may be made five days before the running of the race by the payment of an eligibility fee of \$5,000. Starters to pay \$1,000 additional, with \$100,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 65 per cent

to the owner of the winner, 20 per cent to second, 10 per cent to third and 5 per cent to fourth. Colts, 126 lbs; fillies, 121 lbs. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup, to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession; trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, February 15, 1958, with 132 nominations. Supplementary nominations closed Monday, June 2. Gross value, \$114,600. Gross to winner \$74,490. Net to winner \$73,440; second, \$22,920; third, \$11,460; fourth, \$5,730. Mutuel Pool, \$488,698.

Start good. Won easily. CAVAN moved between horses as TIM TAM began his bid leaving the upper turn, was kept to the inside entering the stretch and, after establishing a clear lead near the furlong post, drew clear and won with something left. TIM TAM, in hard to the mile, was sent up on the outside and settled into the stretch within striking distance of CAVAN, swerved repeatedly when punished and was unable to reach the winner, then pulled up lame after the finish. FLAMINGO outran to the last three-eighths mile, passed tired horses during the stretch run but could not threaten the leaders. NASCO saved ground throughout but was unable to reach serious contention. CHANCE IT TONY, prominent until near the final turn, came way suddenly. MARTINS RULLAH raced well to the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. SAFERRIS was through early. PAGE SEVEN had brief speed.
