Supplementary nominations may be made five days before the running by payment of an eligibility fee of \$5,000. \$250 to pass entry box. \$1,000 to start. The second, third and fourth horses to receive \$25,000, \$12,500 and \$6,250, respectively, of the added money. All fees to the Belmont winner. Closed Wednesday, Feb. 15, with 124 nominations.

Value of race \$148,653. Value to winner \$104,900, second \$25,000, third \$12,500, fourth \$6,250. Mutuel pool \$692,053.

IN GATE AT 4.50. OFF AT 4.50 EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME. Start good. Won driving.

SHERLUCK, away alertly, was kept in a forward position within striking distance of GLOBEMASTER until reaching the stretch, took command from the latter near the furlong pole and drew clear while under strong handling. GLOBEMASTER began fast and saved ground while setting the pace to the stretch, continued gamely when hard ridden during the drive but was unable to withstand SHERLUCK. GUADALCANAL, taken in hand early and steadied until near the stretch turn, finished determinedly but was unable to threaten the leaders. AMBIOPOISE, outrun early, drifted out leaving the upper turn and, after making a mild bid near the three-sixteenths mile pole, tired. DR. MILLER, outrun following the break, bore out approaching and entering the stretch but could not get to the top ones when straight during the drive. HITTING AWAY, prominent and saving ground to the stretch, had nothing left. CARRY BACK broke well but was in close quarters from the start, moved to the outside to secu : racing room after three-quarters mile but failed to rally during the stretch run and came back sore after the finish. BAL MUSETTE had early speed but failed to stay. FLUTTERBY, never in serious contention, had no mishap.
