IN GATE AT 4.50. OFF AT 4.50 EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME. Start good. Won driving.

JAIPUR, away alertly, raced in nearest attendance to ADMIRAL'S VOYAGE after the start, moved to the outside of the latter for the stretch run and, responding to strong handling, won in the last strides. ADMIRAL'S VOYAGE went to the front soon after the start and saved ground while setting the pace under light restraint, responded readily when set down through the stretch but was unable to withstand JAIPUR and just missed. CRIMSON SATAN, well placed and reserved for a mile, drifted out at the stretch turn and, bearing in badly during the drive, was forced to check after taking command between calls and gave way through the final furlong. DECIDEDLY, washy during the post parade, dropped back after beginning alertly and was caught in tight quarters at the first turn, moved to the outside approaching the stretch but was unable to threaten the leaders when set down in the drive. DAVID K. and VIMY RIDGE had no mishaps and were unable to reach serious contention. GREEK MONEY prominent until reaching the stretch, had nothing left. FOLK DANCER began slowly and was far back the entire trip.
