IN GATE AT 4.50. OFF AT 4.50 EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME. Start good for all but DETERMINED MAN. Won driving.

QUADRANGLE saved ground from the start and, fortunate to move through on the inside at the initial turn, took command from ORIENTALIST after the mile, settled for the drive with a short lead and, after disposing of NORTHERN DANCER, drew clear while under brisk handling. ROMAN BROTHER, in hand early, moved up fast approaching the stretch and closed gamely but was unable to seriously threaten QUADRANGLE while easily besting the others. NORTHERN DANCER, permitted to reach his best stride after the first quarter mile, moved into a striking position after settling into the back stretch, swerved to the inside at the mile and tired after making a bold challenge near the furlong pole. HILL RISE, well placed from the start, checked slightly when caught between NORTHERN DANCER and ORIENTALIST at the mile, dropped back and could not threaten the leaders when clear for the stretch run. A foul claim against NORTHERN DANCER by HILL RISE'S rider was not allowed. BRAVE LAD, never close, had no mishap. ORIENTALIST set the pace to the mile but had nothing left. DETERMINED MAN reared at the start and was always far back. SHOCK stopped after showing brief speed.
