IN GATE AT 5:15. OFF AT 5:15; EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME. Start good. Won driving.

AMBEROID, slow to reach his best stride steadily improved after the initial quarter mile, moved

out slightly approaching and entering the stretch but took command before reaching the furlong pole and drew clear while under brisk urging. BUFFLE, in hand and saving ground until near the final turn, made a bold bid near midstretch but was unable to threaten AMBEROID while easily besting the others. ADVOCATOR forwardly placed and reserved until reaching the stretch, was unable to menace the leaders when set down in the drive. KAUI KING away alertly was kept under snug restraint but raced rank until settling into the back stretch went to the front and made the pace until inside the front stretch, but tired during the drive. JOLLY JET had no mishap in a fair performance. FAST COUNT began sluggishly and was never dangerous. STUPENDOUS hard hurtled early, checked slightly when HIGHEST HONORS gave way, recovered under alert handling and made a good challenge approaching the stretch but had nothing left. REHABILITATE dropped out of serious contention soon after the start. VALAM was finished early. FLEET SHOE, never close had no excuse. HIGHEST HONORS set the pace for five eighths but gave way when challenged by KAUI KING.
