HIGH ECHELON saved ground while outrun early, moved up steadily leaving the five-eighths mile pole and, after sent to the outside approaching the stretch, responded to strong handling during the drive, disposed of the leaders inside the final furlong and held NEEDLES N PENS safe. The latter, away slowly saved ground while working his way forward, was sent to the middle of the track entering the stretch and finished strongly. NASKRA, prominent from the start, reached the front between calls inside midstretch but faltered slightly near the finish CLIMBER took an early lead, saved ground while making the pace until inside the stretch and continued courageously but was not good enough. MY DAD GEORGE, reserved for seven-eighths of a mile, made a good bid leaving the upper turn but tired, AGGRESSIVELY disliked the sloppy track and was finished early STOP TIME, never close, had no mishap, SON EXCELLENCE moved up boldly at the mile but had nothing left. DELAWARE CHIEF and HARK THE LARK had early speed but failed to stay.
