1½ MILES. (2:24). One-hundred-and-seventh running BELMONT. SCALE WEIGHTS. \$150,000 added. 3-year-olds. By subscription of \$100 each, to accompany the nomination; \$250 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. A supplementary nomination may be made by payment of \$2,500 at the closing time of entries, plus an additional \$10,000 to start. \$150,000 added, of which 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and geldings, 126 lbs.; fillies, 121 lbs. The winning owner will be

presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, Feb. 15, 1975, with 211 nominations.

Ch. c, by Graustark—Brown Berry, by Mount Marcy. Trainer, A. T. Doyle. Bred by A. A. Seeligson, Jr. (Ky.). AVATAR, away in good order, was rated along behind the leaders while racing well out in the track, continued along the outside to go after MASTER DERBY nearing the stretch, took over soon after straightening away, opened a clear lead inside the final furlong and was under pressure to turn back FOOLISH PLEASURE. The latter, unhurried early, commenced to rally nearing the end of the backstretch, came out to continue his move nearing the stretch and finished strongly. MASTER DERBY, allowed to follow DIABOLO while well in hand, moved to the fore from between horses near the three-eighths pole but weakened during the drive. DIABOLO sprinted clear racing into the first turn, made the pace while racing well out from the inner rail, remained a factor to the upper stretch and gave way. PRINCE THOU ART, void of early foot, passed tired horses. SINGH, a forward factor to the far turn, tired badly. JUST THE TIME was always outrun. NALEES RIALTO, well placed until near the far turn, had nothing left. SYLLABUS showed nothing.
