The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and geldings, 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs.

GO AND GO, under stout restraint early, moved within easy striking distance along the inside midway along the backstretch, came out from behind the leaders approaching the stretch, caught THIRTY SIX RED nearing the final furlong and drew off under brisk urging. THIRTY SIX RED went right to the front along the inside, raced well out from the rail while showing speed into the backstretch, dueling with BARON DE VAUX to the stretch but was no match for the winner. BARON DE VAUX, sent up along the inside early, headed THIRTY SIX RED after going five and one-half furlongs, dueling with that rival to the stretch while continuing to save ground and tired. UNBRIDLED, never far back while racing outside horses, made a run from the outside at the far turn, but was finished entering the stretch. YONDER, outrun, early, moved up while racing wide on the far turn but gave way under pressure. LAND RUSH tired badly while racing wide. VIDEO RANGER failed to be a serious factor. HAWAIIAN PASS raced forwardly until near the end of the backstretch and stopped badly. COUNTRY DAY stumbled badly when caught in close quarters soon after the start and was far back when his rider lost the whip leaving the far turn.
